Interstate competitor registrations

Registration forms from competitors residing interstate:

1. Please try and get registrations in early
2. If submitting registrations prior to the closing date for registrations, they can be emailed or posted to The Climbing Edge without payment and payment can be made on the morning of the competition, prior to the time for close of late registrations, without a late fee being applied

Family/friends of competitors will be welcome to climb on Sunday 8 August 2010, but will have to pay the usual entry/hire fees.

Location

The Climbing Edge is located in Hobart Central Business District a block and a half from the Elizabeth Street Mall in the heart of the City. To find The Climbing Edge from the Mall, walk up Elizabeth Street to the corner of Bathurst Street and look for the Mountain Designs store. Turn left on that corner and walk up past the small open air car park, past Badgers Makes Badgers (a work clothing store) and turn left into the little lane directly beside Badgers Makes Badgers. The Climbing Edge entry is at the very bottom of that lane.

Parking

There is no parking down our laneway. There are half hour parking meters right outside of The Climbing Edge. Around the corner in Argyle Street, there are 3 hour metres and two public carparks.

Accommodation & transport (Ten Buck Bus)

Being in the centre of the city, there is heaps of accommation nearby. The Ten Buck Bus www.tenbuckbus.com.au picks up from the airport and stops at all major accommodation locations in the city. They are armed with the Nationals running sheet and will be able to get you to the venue or your accommodation, straight from the airport.
