



Job Description for the World Youth Championships Coaching Position 2010

AUSTRALIAN WORLD YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM

Sport Climbing Australia is seeking applicants to fill the role of Coach for the Australian World Youth Championship Team, travelling to The World Youth Championships in Edinburgh, Scotland, U.K., 9th-12th September 2010.

POSITION CRITERIA

~ The WYC Coach would be expected to organise and run a series of regular training sessions, designed to help the competitors prepare physically and mentally for the event and to help the team to bond. Ideally, the training schedule would consist of 10 sessions over a 5 month period.

~ The WYC Coach would also be expected to travel to the event and support the athletes leading up to, and at the event. A team training in Scotland would be organised and run by the coach, early that week.

~ Pending the outcome of the WYC team selection, the final number of competitors shall determine compensation to the coach. This money (to be determined) will be collected in the form of either training fees or donations from the competitors, for the purpose of assisting the coach with their overseas travel expenses.
